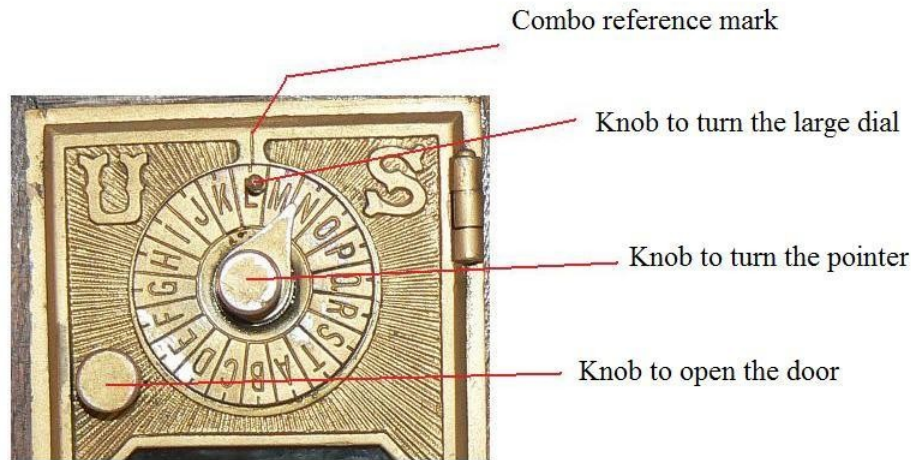


Dial Ray style PO Box Door

You would have started seeing these Dial Ray PO Box Doors show up in your Post offices starting in 1896. They were produced by The Eagle Lock Company for the USPS.



Instructions:

Memorize your combination. Also, write it down and keep it in a safe place. The combination is located on the bottom of the box. Besides the combination, there will also be a number. If you lose the combination, write to me, giving that number and I should be able to give you the combination.

Your combination may consist of two letters. Example: S – E. The first letter is for the large dial, while the second letter is for the pointer. NOTE: The illustration is set to L & N.

Rotate the large dial, aligning the appropriate letter with the combo reference mark. Rotate the pointer to its appropriate letter.

Turn the knob to the right, clockwise and pull to open.

These doors are old and have been in many years of service. Some jiggling and finessing might be needed until you are comfortable with opening them. I give them a healthy cleaning in a simple green solution to remove the heavy grime. I try to leave them in as original state as I receive them.
