

# *Grecian style PO Box Door*

You would have started seeing these Grecian PO Box Doors show up in your Post offices starting in 1955 through the mid – 1980s. They were produced by many different manufactures for the USPS.

Instructions:



Grecian:

Memorize your combination. Also, write it down and keep it in a safe place. The combination will consist of three sets of letter(s). The combination is locate on the bottom of the box. Besides the combination, there will also be a number. If you lose the combination, write to me, giving that number and I should be able to give you the combination.

You combination may consist of 1 – 2 letters per set. Example: AB – F – IJ

AB is a set, so is F. For a set of AB, you would move the small arrow to the middle of the 2 letters. If it is a single letter (F), you would move the small arrow to the top of the letter.

Turn the dial to the right a couple of times, stopping at your first set.

Turn the dial to the left going past your first set to your second set.

Turn the dial to the right going directly to your third set.

Open the lock.

These doors are old and have been in many years of service. Some jiggling and finessing might be need until you are comfortable with opening them. I give them a healthy cleaning in a simple green solutions to remove the heavy grim. I try to leave them in as original state as I receive them.
